SHAW AFB, SC - The U.S. Air Force 337th Recruiting Squadron is honored to announce that Jones Senior's Travonda Haddock & Davie County's Nate Jones are the U.S. Air Force High Flyers of the Year for North Carolina. Haddock averaged 17.4 points, 9.1 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 5.1 blocks per game for Jones Senior. Davie County's Jones scored 40 points in a win over West Forsyth to earn the week five U.S. Air Force High Flyer honor while earning Central Piedmont Conference Most Valuable Player honor.

Fans from across the state voted for the High Flyers of the Year. Jones received 3,209 votes while Highland Tech's Jevon Patton was second with 3,091 votes and Chapel Hill's Denzel Ingram finished third (2,097) in the voting. Haddock won the girl's honor with 2,998 votes while Northwood's Shelby Wolfe (1,538) finished second while Richmond Senior's Tierra Ellerbe finished third with 1,286 votes.
