The seven-on-seven tournament will feature teams from throughout the District of Columbia and southern Maryland. The U.S. Marine Corps' partnership with the passing league ensures that the first 16 teams will not be charged to participate.

The single-day event will feature 16-20 teams, with each team guaranteed to play a minimum of four games. Each team will play three games in pool play to determine the seeding for the single-elimination championship round.

The U.S. Marine Corps Passing League - Maryland is a traditional seven-on-seven non-contact passing league played on a shortened field with only passing plays from the line of scrimmage. The games feature quarterbacks, wide receivers, running backs, and defensive backs, giving these skill players an opportunity to sharpen their skills in a fun, competitive atmosphere.

Although the league is restricted to those student-athletes who are enrolled in high school, the participating teams of the U.S. Marine Corps - Passing League Maryland are not associated with or representative of any high school football program in the state of Maryland.

Calvin Coolidge Senior High School is located at 6315 5th Street Northwest in Washington, D.C. The tournament will be played on Coolidge's turf field and on secondary grass fields that are operated by the District of Columbia Parks & Recreation.
