Cedric Stokes – Trenton	Stokes scored two touchdowns in a 33-27 win over Lafayette. He returned a kickoff 90 yards for a score and rushed for 101 yards with a touchdown on offense
Austin Chipoletti – Bradford	Chipoletti accounted for all the scoring in Bradford's 12-9 win over Palatka. He hit two field goals, including the overtime winner and also scored on an 11-yard run that forced OT
Damonte Jones – St. John's Lutheran	Jones had two touchdown runs of 47 and 10 yards on offense as St. John's beat Bronson 51-0. He also scored on an 88-yard punt return.
Daniel Franklin – Forest	Franklin was a force on defense with two interceptions, including one he returned 92 yards for a touchdown. He also returned a fumble 87 yards for a score as Forest beat Lake Weir 58-6. Franklin scored on a 25-yard end around on offense.
Tyriq Jones - Hilliard	Jones had a touchdown catch of 33 yards as Hilliard beat St. Joseph 20-7. He also scored on a blocked punt, finished with three sacks and had 58 yards rushing.
