Keynnard Campbell – Bible Baptist	Campbell had two touchdown tosses and returned a kick-off for a 68-yard score as Bible Baptist knocked off St. Andrew's, 38-8.
Demetrius Green – West Laurens	Green scored on a 94-yard kick-off return for a touchdown and rushed for two touchdowns as West Laurens beat Howard, 41-21.
Tony Hunter – South Effingham	Hunter scored two rushing touchdowns and kicked seven extra-points (7-for-7) in South Effingham's 49-42 win over Johnson.
Alex Knight – Jones County	Knight blocked a 47-yard field-goal attempt and returned an interception for a 40-yard score in Jones County's 29-28 loss of McIntosh.
