Army Iron Man - Week 1 Nominees - Kansas

Tyler Pike – Chetopa	Pike rushed for two touchdowns in a 64-6 win over Altoona-Midway. He also had a receiving touchdown and recorded an interception on defense
Kip Keeley – LaCrosse	Keeley had 109 yards and a touchdown on the ground, leading LaCrosse to a 57-14 win over Larned. He also had a receiving touchdown and an interception on defense.
Brennan Stotts - Skyline	Stotts rushed for 101 yards in a 50-12 win over Stafford. He also had 82 receiving yards and a touchdown. On defense, he led the team with nine tackles and had a 60-yard punt return for a touchdown on special teams.
Jordan Hart - McPherson	Hart accounted for six touchdowns in McPherson’s 47-21 win over Andover. He had three rushing touchdowns, finishing with 51 yards on the ground. He had two touchdown catches, finishing with 149 yards receiving and had a 65-yard punt return for a touchdown.
Jordan Lewis – Mission Valley	Lewis rushed for 85 yards and a touchdown on offense as Mission Valley beat Northern Heights 42-6. He also had two interceptions on defense and finished with seven tackles.
