Darian Bass- CBC	Bass caught a 25-yard touchdown pass, helping CBC beat Howell Central 64-0. He also returned a fumble 15-yards for a touchdown on defense.
Jared White - DeSoto	White had two offensive touchdowns leading DeSoto to a 52-7 win over Perryville. He scored on a 22-yard run and a 68-yard reception. He also recorded an interception on defense.
Chris Savage – Union	Savage had two rushing touchdowns in a 63-22 win over Vashon. He also returned an interception 50 yards for a touchdown
Evan Roush – Quincy Notre Dame	Roush returned a punt 30-yards for a touchdown and added a five yard touchdown run on offense in a 42-0 win over Northwest Academy
