Jestin Brown – Altavista	Brown rushed for 98 yards, scored two rushing touchdowns, and returned a kick-off for a 73-yard score in Altavista's 50-29 win over Randolph-Henry.
Uriah Hammond – Rustburg	Hammond played both ways for Rustburg making several tackles on defense while rushing for 129 yards with a touchdown as Rustburg opened with a 38-13 win over William Campbell.
Marion Harris – Petersburg	Harris returned an interception for a 90-yard touchdown and scored on an 18-yard run as Petersburg edged George Washington-Danville 34-33.
Jerome Robinson – Blessed Sacrament Huguenot	Robinson returned the season-opening kick-off for a 74 yard score while rushing for 121 yards on eight carries with a 77 – yard scoring run as Blessed Sacrament Huguenot knocked off Kenston Forest, 42-13.
Doug Sizemore – William Monroe	Sizemore rushed for 117-yards with a touchdown, had a 30-yard scoring catch, threw for 68 yards, and returned a fumble for a 19-yard touchdown as William Monroe beat Nelson County, 34-6.
