10 Hartford is one of the nation's top teams when it comes to protecting the three, ranking 10th after holding opponents to a .287 clip.
10 Grad student Traci Carter continues to wreak havoc on opponents' offense, ranking first in the AE and 10th in the nation with 2.6 steals per game.
21.3 Senior Austin Williams has been on a tear during Hartford's postseason run, averaging a team-best 21.7 points in three America East Playoff games.

SERIES NOTEBOOK

- Hartford and Baylor meet for the third time on Friday
- It is the two teams' first meeting outside of Waco, Texas
- The Bears won the previous two meetings, taking a 74-59 decision in 2008 before edging the Hawks by a 71-69 final the following year

A WIN ON FRIDAY WOULD...

- mark Hartford's first-ever NCAA Tournament victory
- be the Hawks' first win against a nationally-ranked team
- extend Hartford's winning streak to six games
- propel the Hawks into the Round of 32 for the first time in program history

SCOUTING BAYLOR

- For the first time in program history, the second-ranked Bears were selected as a No. 1 seed — and No. 2 overall behind top-ranked Gonzaga — in the NCAA Tournament
- The Bears are 22-2 overall, but lost in the Big 12 Championship Game to #12 Oklahoma State, 83-74
- Leading the nation in three-point field goal percentage (.418), the Bears' offense ranks third nationally at 84.4 ppg
- Jared Butler (17.1 ppg) has lit it up from three this season, as his .429 percentage is the 11th-best clip in the nation

LAST TIME THEY MET

- The Bears fought for a 71-69 win on Nov. 15, 2009, in Waco
- Ekpe Udoh hit a 20-foot turnaround jump shot at the buzzer to send Baylor to victory
- Joe Zeglinski scored 23 points for the Hawks, who led most of the way

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- March 13 will be remembered as one of the most significant moments in Hartford men's basketball history
- In their first time hosting an America East Championship Game, the Hawks were crowned league champions for the first time in program history
- With the win, Hartford earned the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament berth

IT'S ALL BEEN DONE

- Hartford will look to repeat the feat of fellow conference-mate UMBC when it faces #1 Baylor Friday
- The Retrievers shocked the world and made NCAA Tournament history in 2018 when they upended #1 Virginia in the First Round
- The win was a convincing one, as UMBC won by a final score of 74-54 on March 16

LAST TIME OUT

- Senior Austin Williams scored 20 points, and grad student added 16 as the fourth-seeded Hawks defeated No. 6 UMass Lowell, 64-50, to claim the

program's first-ever America East Championship

- Hartford, which shot 50.0 percent in the second half, used a key 10-0 run late in the game to pull away from the River Hawks
- It marked the first time in America East history that the No. 1 or No. 2 seed did not advance to the Championship Game

TOP MARK

- Although unconventional in nature, the 2020-21 season has been one of the most successful in program history
- This season's .720 winning percentage is the best since Hartford joined the Division I ranks for the 1984-85 campaign
- The previous Division I program record for best winning percentage was .607, in 1996-97 (17-11)
- Overall, the Hawks' top winning percentage came in 1969-70, when they went 19-3 for a .864 mark

ZERO-POINT LINE

- Baylor enters Friday's game as the top three-point shooting team in the nation, but Hartford is No. 10 in the nation in protecting the three-point line
- The Hawks have held opponents to 28.7 percent shooting from behind the arc this season
- Opponents have been held below the 30.0 percent threshold 13 times this season
- UMass Lowell was held to 16.7 percent from long range by Hartford's defense this past Saturday
- Last season, the Hawks held opponents to 27.5 percent shooting from long range, the second-best mark in NCAA Division I

NEXT ON TAP

- The winner of Friday's game advances to the Second Round to face either No. 8 North Carolina or No. 9 Wisconsin
- The Second Round begins on Sunday, March 21

HOW WE GOT HERE

- Williams poured in a career-high 29 points as fourth-seeded Hartford ran out to a 21-11 lead and never looked back in a 77-60 defeat of No. 9 Binghamton (Feb. 27)
- Less than 24 hours later, the Hawks pushed past No. 5 UAlbany, 83-77, behind five double-figure scorers (Feb. 28)
- Led by a combined 47 points from Williams and Carter, Hartford pulled off the semifinal upset against a dominant Vermont squad, taking down the No. 2 seed by a 71-65 final (March 6)

COMMUNICATIONS

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▪ One week later, the Hawks claimed the America East Championship on their home court with a 64-50 win over No. 6 UMass Lowell

▪ Hartford became the first team in America East history to win four games on its way to capturing the league title

POSTSEASON PUSH

▪ The Hawks saved their best basketball for when it matters most: the postseason

▪ Hartford posted an average margin of victory of +10.8 throughout the America East Playoffs, including a 17-point win in the opening round victory against Binghamton (Feb. 27)

▪ The Hawks scored at least 70 points in three of their four wins, including a season-best 83 in the quarterfinal victory vs. UAlbany (Feb. 28), and averaged 73.8 points through the postseason

▪ The Hawks have also put on a shooting clinic, going .488 from the field and .373 from long range

MR. POSTSEASON

▪ Named the America East Championship's Most Outstanding Player, Williams has been a key factor in Hartford's current postseason run

▪ He scored 20+ points in three of four Hawks' wins

▪ Williams averaged 21.3 points in the postseason, after averaging 12.3 ppg in 19 regular-season games

▪ Most impressively, Williams has been virtually unstoppable from the field, going 61 percent (27-of-44), including 57 percent from long range

▪ Typically known for his ability to penetrate to the rim, eight of his 22 makes from three have come during the postseason

A FULL CIRCLE

▪ Hartford advanced to the Championship Game for the second time in program history in 2019-20, after defeating No. 6 UMass Lowell in the quarterfinals and No. 2 Stony Brook in the semifinals

▪ The Hawks' postseason run came to a tragic end, though, as hours before loading the bus to head to top-seeded Vermont, the title game was abruptly canceled due to COVID-19

▪ Three-hundred and sixty-six days later, the Hawks found themselves right where they started from just over a year ago, with a chance to play for their first-ever America East Championship and ticket to the Big Dance

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM

▪ This season marked the third time that Hartford advanced to the America East Championship Game

▪ The Hawks made their first-ever title game appearance in 2008, where they fell short at top-seeded UMBC as the No. 2 seed

▪ Last season, Hartford was set to battle top-seeded Vermont for the America East Championship, but that game was not played due to the COVID-19 pandemic

CHECK OUT THESE NUMBERS

▪ A workhorse on the court, Carter's numbers have been impressive on both ends of the court in 2020-21

▪ Recording 2.6 steals and 11.7 points per game, he is the first player in 31 years to average 2.5+ steals and 10.0+ points in the same season

▪ The only other player to have put up similar numbers was Lamont Middleton, who averaged 2.5 steals and 18.9 points in 28 games in 1989-90

4-FOR-4

▪ Hartford has finished in the top-four of the America East standings in each of the past four years

▪ The 2020-21 campaign marked the second time in that stretch that the Hawks are the No. 4 seed (2019, 2021)

▪ Hartford entered the postseason as the No. 3 seed in both 2018 and 2020

4-FOR-4, PART II

▪ Hartford made its program-best fourth consecutive semifinal appearance in 2020-21

▪ The upset of No. 2 Vermont marked the second straight season that the Hawks qualified for the Championship Game

20-20 VISION

▪ For the first time this season, Hartford landed a pair of 20-point scorers in the same game in the semifinal victory at No. 2 Vermont (March 6)

▪ The tandem of Williams (25 points) and Carter (22) was lethal, as they combined for more than half of the Hawks' 71 points against the Catamounts with 47

▪ It marked the first time since 2019-20 that two Hawks netted 20+ points in the same game, when Carter (26 points) and former grad student Malik Ellison (23) accomplished the feat against Vermont (Feb. 8, 2020)

CARTER LEADS THREE AE HONOREES

▪ Three different Hawks combined to for four All-Conference awards last month

▪ Carter was named to the Second Team after receiving Third Team distinction in 2020

▪ He was also named to the All-Defensive Team, making him just the second player in program history to earn the honor twice (Corban Wroe: 2014, 2015)

▪ In his first year with the Hawks, Williams earned a spot on the Third Team

▪ Rounding out the awards was Marks, who received All-Academic Team honors for the second straight season

▪ He becomes the third repeat All-Academic Team member in program history, joining Wroe (2014, 2015) and Jaret von Rosenberg (2008, 2009)

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

▪ The Hawks had a huge advantage inside Reich Family Pavilion in 2020-21

▪ Hartford, which won more home games than any other team in the league (10), also finished with the America East's best home winning percentage (.909)

▪ In 11 home games, Hartford averaged 71.3 points, compared to 61.6 points in road contests (12 games)

▪ The Hawks averaged 1.5 more makes from three at home (8.5) on 36.9 percent shooting, compared to 28.7 percent on the road

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM...

▪ Hartford has proven everyone wrong after a preseason projection that landed the Hawks in the bottom half of the America East Coaches' Poll (6th)

▪ The Hawks were also picked to finish sixth in the 2019-20 preseason poll, but made it to the Championship Game as the No. 3 seed in the tournament

KEY-POINT LINE

▪ The three-point line has been a key factor in Hartford's success under head coach John Gallagher

▪ The Hawks are averaging 7.6 threes per game, second-most in the league

▪ 34 percent of Hartford's offense comes from behind the arc

DEE-FENCE

▪ One of Hartford's most dangerous qualities is its defense

▪ The Hawks have held opponents to 63.3 points per game, making them the top defensive team in the America East

▪ That mark is the 24th-best in the nation

▪ They were even stingier in conference play, holding league foes to just 61.9 ppg

▪ They have buckled down to hold six opponents to 59 points or fewer this season

▪ UMass Lowell recently fell victim to

Hartford's stifling defense, as it was held to just 50 points in the America East Championship Game

CARTER HITS A MILESTONE

▪ Carter hit two key milestones in his Hartford career at Stony Brook in January

▪ He made his 50th career start, and scored his 500th point on second-half three, in the same game (Jan. 31)

▪ Carter, who has scored 589 points in two seasons at Hartford, joins teammate Marks in the 500-point club

▪ His 56 starts are tied with Marks for the most among current Hawks

HUNTER'S NOTABLE MARKS

▪ Marks became the first active Hartford player to reach 500 career points against Stony Brook (Jan. 30)

▪ He reached the mark late in the game on a three-pointer with 91 seconds left

- Williams leads the pack with 13.9 points per game
- Despite his scoring average being the seventh-best in the America East, it is the lowest mark for Hartford's leading scorer since 2014-15, when Mark Nwakamma ('15) averaged led the offense with 12.1 points per game

WEBLEY'S WEEKLY AWARDS

- Hartford's first recruit from New Zealand, freshman Thomas Webley has landed quality minutes in the front court
- He earned a weekly award from the America East a team-best two times, taking home a pair of Rookie of the Week honors
- Most recently, Webley was tabbed Rookie of the Week on Feb. 15 after averaging 7.0 points and 4.5 boards in 39 minutes against NJIT

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

GRAND THEFT AUTO

- A two-time All-Defensive Team member, Carter leads the America East and is 10th in the nation with 2.6 steals per game
- he has registered five-or-more steals in a game four times this season, including a season-high in a win against Binghamton (Jan. 3)
- In 2020-21, Carter finished sixth in the nation and shattered Hartford's single-season record after registering 83 thefts
- He also broke Hartford's 20-year-old single-game record by one steal after recording nine in the win at UAlbany (Jan. 25, 2020)

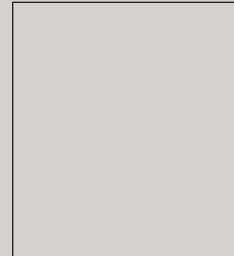
