<u>Moscow</u> QB: Breck Roop WR: Osvaldo Granillo	Roop threw four touchdown strikes (14, 35, 1, 79), hitting Granillo on three of the scores as Moscow outscored Balko (OK), 88-48.
<u>Olathe North</u> QB: Jordan Bruce WR: Tanner Gentry	Bruce hit Gentry on a pair of scoring strikes on tosses of 29 and 25 yards in leading Olathe North to a 29-14 win over Olathe East.
<u>Sunrise Christian</u> QB: Zach Howell WR: Preston Atherton	Howell threw for 529 yards, hitting 40 of his 54 attempts, with four touchdowns and connected with Preston Atherton for 257 yards in a 26-13 win over Christ Prep.

<u>Olathe Northwest</u> QB: Dalton Rook WR: Willie Cauley	Rook connected with Cauley on four touchdown tosses as Olathe Northwest beat Leavenworth, 40-14.
