<u>Bishop Miego</u> QB: Montel Cozart WR: McKinley Johnson	Cozart was 19 of 28 with 233 yards and four touchdown tosses, including two scoring strikes to McKinley Johnson (24, 45) in Bishop Miego's 34-0 win over Gardner Edgerton.
<u>Dodge City</u> QB: Taylor Murphy WR: Isaiah Bradshaw	Murphy threw for 280 yards with three scores in Dodge City's 63-6 win over North. Bradshaw had five receptions for 94 yards with a score.
<u>Herington</u> QB: Dylan Geissert WR: Dylan Barber	Geissert had 30 completions for 418 yards with four scores in Herington's 42-26 win over Council Grove. Barber had four catches for 113 yards and two scores.
<u>Lawrence Free State</u> QB: Kyle McFarland WR: Calloway Schmidt	McFarland completed 10 for 19 with 205 yards and five touchdowns, connecting with Calloway Schmidt on the game-winning scoring strike from 28 yards out late in the fourth-quarter.
<u>Macksville</u> QB: Seth Filbert WR: Adam Oak	Filbert threw for 367 yards with four touchdowns with Oak making 12 catches for 252 yards and all four scores in Macksville's 48-14 win over Fairfield.

<u>Mulvane</u> QB: Ty Redington WR: Todd Parton	Redington was 20 for 34 with 325 yards and four touchdowns in Mulvane's 40-12 win over Pratt. Redington connected with Parton on five passes for 106 yards with two touchdowns.
