Integrated Sports Marketing

The Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR campaign combined radio advertising, earned media, interactive, and event marketing to engage, energize your audience to generate leads for your Marines.

Logo Development

TSF Radio Network's design team created a logo identity for the campaign that was used in all marketing materials throughout the campaign.

Radio Advertising

"The Sports Flash" (TSF) Radio Network supported the campaign with radio advertising on our network affiliates in Texas.

Earned Media

Our earned media efforts generated free media coverage in newspapers throughout the recruiting territory, including: *The Oklahoman*; *San Antonio Express-News*; and the *Austin American-Statesman*.

Interactive Media

Each week, the campaign drove web traffic to the campaign site, where fans voted for the weekly winner. During the campaign, TSF Radio Network had 924,055 hits to the web site and recorded 262,485 votes.

Event Marketing

Each Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Week received a certificate, tee-shirt in a presentation ceremony that included the Marine recruiters responsible for each particular school.

Overview

The Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Week honored the best high school football players in Arizona, Dallas, Houston, Oklahoma, and San Antonio. The integrated marketing campaign is designed to engage the student-athletes, their peers, parents, coaches, and the community.

High school football is woven into the fabric of many small towns across America. It's the biggest game in town; one of the few places where the community comes together. The Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR campaign taps into the energy of Friday night and carries it throughout the week.

The Basics

Each week, during the high school football season, TSF Radio Network solicited nominations from fans, coaches, administrators, and the media for the Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Week. Through press releases, earned media, and radio advertising, fans were encouraged to go online and vote for the weekly winner. Each week, TSF Radio Network had between 10-15 nominees per state.

TSF Radio Network distributed the press releases each week to our database of media, schools, and coaches. We sent out the press releases at the beginning of the week that announced the weekly nominees and another press release at the end of the week to announce the weekly winner.

TSF Radio Network also specifically targeted the sports media that was local to each nominee. In addition, we faxed, e-mailed the press release to the school of each nominee. Often, the schools would put the information on their web pages, on their facebook pages, and include the information in their morning announcements.

Fans had the opportunity to vote online through 9:00 P.M. each Thursday evening. The winner was announced on Friday.

The weekly winners received a tee-shirt, certificate as the Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Week from Marines who visited the school to make the presentation to the honoree. Each weekly winner was a finalist for the Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Year. Voting for the Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the Year lasted for two weeks. Each Marine Corps ELITE WARRIOR of the YEAR will receive a trophy honoring the accomplishment.

Logo Development

TSF Radio Network's design team worked to create an identity for the campaign. We worked to ensure that the logo met the Marine Corps branding guidelines, using the traditional Marine Corps colors and properly incorporating the Marine Corps' eagle, globe, and anchor into the design. We wanted the logo to convey football at first glance, while at the same time having a scholastic, yet military feel.



After careful consideration, the Marines selected a helmet logo that included the Eagle, Anchor, and Globe inside the helmet that rested on a "VARSITY" font of "U.S. MARINE CORPS ELITE WARRIOR OF THE WEEK." We even added a logo that included the copy of "U.S. MARINE CORPS ELITE WARRIOR OF THE YEAR." The logo was used for the campaign materials, press releases for the voting for the "Elite Warrior of the Year."

Direct Mail

TSF Radio Network drafted an introductory letter to introduce the U.S. Marine Corps Elite Warrior campaign to high school football coaches, athletic directors at targeted high schools throughout each recruiting territory.

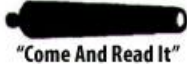

Local weekend warriors to possibly earn Elite Warrior status

Five Central Texas football players have been named finalists for the Marine Corps Elite Warrior of the Year award.

Westlake senior running back **Brice Dolezal**, Regents senior defensive back **Dawson Gamble**, Hutto senior quarterback **Ryan Higgins**, Manor senior quarterback **Jacorie McQueen** and Lockhart junior running back **Marcos Rodriguez** are five of the 10 finalists for the San Antonio area award. Awards will be given away for the Arizona, Ohio, Oklahoma, Dallas, Houston and San Antonio areas.

Dolezal has rushed for 1,422 yards and 16 touchdowns this fall for a Westlake team that has reached the area playoffs. Dolezal is averaging seven yards per carry.

An All-Central Texas defensive back in 2010, Gamble has caught nine touchdown passes and rushed for six scores this season.

A season after setting school records for passing yards and touchdowns in a single season, Higgins led Hutto to a share of another District 16-4A championship this fall.

McQueen threw for over 3,000 yards and 29 touchdowns this season for a Manor team that reached the bi-district playoffs.

Rodriguez helped Lockhart's transition into new coach Paul Kilby's slot-T offense. His breakout game came on Sept. 9 when he rushed for three touchdowns and had a 92-yard touchdown catch in a 57-24 win over Travis.

Fan voting for this award began on Monday and it will run through Nov. 27. The honorees will be announced on Nov. 28.

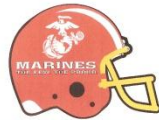

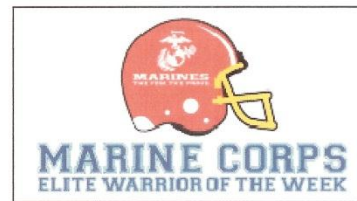

4 - Judson running backs who have rushed for 300 yards in a game. Quaylon Jones had 315 yards on Friday against Churchill, joining Matt Hare (350 vs. Taft, 1996), Jerod Douglas (337 vs. Lee, 1992) and Kyle Fox (331 vs. O'Connor, 2004) in accomplishing the feat.

13 - Straight quarters Marion has shut out its opponents. The only score the Bulldogs have allowed this season was a third-quarter TD in an 8-7 season-opening loss to Poth. They've since shut out Karnes City, Cole and Randolph.

45 - Consecutive District 26-5A volleyball matches Reagan had won until Tuesday's five-game loss against MacArthur. It was the Rattlers' first district setback since falling to Churchill on Sept. 2, 2008, and their first loss ever against the Brahmas.

5-19 - Combined record of the six teams in District 28-5A. Corpus Christi Carroll has three of those victories. East Central is the only San Antonio team in 28-5A to win a game through four weeks.

7,258 - Dollars raised by the Steele volleyball team during its third annual "Digs for a Cure" night on Sept. 9. Proceeds go to the Alamo Breast Cancer Foundation and will be used for such things as providing free mammograms for women who can't afford to pay for them. The Knights have raised \$18,958 during the three seasons that they have held the event.

Odds and ends

Sadler snags honor: Devine running back Joseph Sadler was named the Built Ford Tough High School Player of the Week for Class 3A after rushing for 336 yards and scoring six touchdowns in a 41-19 win over Medina Valley last week. He also kicked an extra point, scored a 2-point conversion and played defense as the Warhorses improved to 4-0.

Sadler leads the area with 1,128 rushing yards and 21 total touchdowns through four games.

Solid finish: Jake Judkins of Johnson shot 7-under 137 over two days, capturing medalist honors and spurring the Jaguars to a runner-up team finish at the Bart Granger Memorial Tournament in Fort Worth last week. District 26-5A squads grabbed three of the top seven places in the 53-team field, with Reagan finishing third and Churchill seventh.

Swing for the Cure: The NEISD is hosting the first Swing for the Cure tournament Sept. 30-Oct. 1 at Brackenridge. It ranks as the first 54-hole event for girls players in the state.
