<i>Daxton Cates – Westerville South</i>	Cates had 17 carries for 229 yards rushing with two touchdowns as Westerville South to a 47-18 win over Groveport.
<i>Kumar Collins – Reynoldsburg</i>	Collins rushed for 156 yards with two scores to lead Reynoldsburg to a 31-14 win over Dublin Jerome.
<i>Griffin Dolle – St. Xavier</i>	Dolle threw for 142 yards with two touchdowns and ran for another score in St. Xavier's 30-7 win over Springfield.
<i>Jimmy Dehnke – Jackson</i>	Dehnke dashed for 195 rushing yards with four touchdowns to lead Jackson to a 38-28 win over Copley.
<i>Alex Fox – Canal</i>	Fox amassed 257 yards and scored both touchdowns as Canal beat St. Charles, 12-7.
<i>Cody Fox – Elder</i>	Fox rushed for 164 yards with three touchdowns in leading Elder to a 33-14 win over Centerville.
<i>Ross Franklin – Johnstown</i>	Franklin powered Johnstown past Granville, 38-29, rushing for 330 yards and six touchdowns on 31 carries.
<i>Roblow Givens – Hamilton</i>	Givens rushed for 127 yards with three touchdowns and also grabbed an interception on defense as Hamilton beat Clayton Northmont, 28-14.
<i>Caleb Green – Buckeye Valley</i>	Green ran for 189 yards and scored three touchdowns in leading Buckeye Valley to a 38-32 double-overtime win over Delaware.
<i>Bo Hardy – Ready</i>	Hardy rushed for 171 yards with four scores as Ready beat Franklin Heights, 54-7.
<i>Alden Hill – Marlinton</i>	Hill broke his own single-game school-record with 315 rushing yard with five touchdowns as Marlinton rolled over St. Thomas Aquinas, 46-19.
<i>D.J. Jones – Ravenna</i>	Jones had 289 yards rushing with four scores as Ravenna beat Tallmadge, 47-44.

<i>Brenden Kemp – Watkins Memorial</i>	Kemp scampered for 181 with three touchdowns as Watkins Memorial beat Licking Heights, 51-21.
<i>Alex Mickley – Hilliard Davidson</i>	Mickley carried the ball for 143 yards and scored four touchdowns in Hilliard Davidson's 28-7 win over Grove City.
<i>Jordan Morris – North</i>	Morris rushed for 307 yards on 34 carries and scored three touchdowns in North's 51-20 win over Brush.
<i>Martine Perez – Eastmoor Academy</i>	Perez returned the second-half kick-off for a 90-yard score and rushed for 107 yards and two touchdowns in Eastmoor Academy's 32-13 win over Northland.
<i>Dan Piascik – Benedictine</i>	Piascik slung the ball for 307 yards and two touchdowns as Benedictine edged Boardman, 31-30.
<i>Tommy Saviers – Waterloo</i>	Saviers ran through Southington Chalker for 281 yards and five touchdowns in Waterloo's 49-19 victory.
<i>Blake Scipio – Hilliard Bradley</i>	Scipio ran the ball for 167 yards with a touchdown in Hilliard Bradley's 39-10 win over Dublin Scioto.
<i>Aaron Williams – Hamilton Township</i>	Williams returned two punts for touchdowns as Hamilton Township rallied for a 27-23 win over Chillicothe. Williams returned both punts for touchdowns (61, 78) in the fourth-quarter for Hamilton Township.
