Marine Corps Elite Warrior of the Week - Nominees

<i>Kevin Beeser – St. Vincent-St. Mary</i>	Beeser was 17-for-22 passing with 234 yards with four touchdowns, no interceptions, and ran for another score in St. Vincent-St. Mary's 39-14 win over St. Johns College.
<i>Tra Chapman – Kent Roosevelt</i>	Chapman had 338 yards of total offense with four touchdowns to lead Kent Roosevelt to a 55-28 win over Stow. Chapman rushed for 178 yards with two scores and passed for 160 yards with two more touchdowns in the Kent Roosevelt win.
<i>Ahmad Eggleston – Girard</i>	Eggleston had 203 yards rushing on 11 carries with three touchdowns to lead Girard to a 49-17 win over Warren JFK.
<i>Da'Junn Graham – Maple Heights</i>	Graham had 239 yards of total offense with four touchdowns to lead Maple Heights to a 26-13 win over Chadron.
<i>Tajuan Green – Brookhaven</i>	Green had 409 yards of total offense and six touchdowns to lead Brookhaven to a 51-21 win over Fairfield. Green threw for 163 yards with three scores and ran for 246 yards with three touchdowns.
<i>Ja'les Hughes – Campbell Memorial</i>	Hughes rushed for 212 yards and scored four touchdowns as Campbell Memorial knocked off Liberty, 33-3.
<i>Drew McArtor – Licking Valley</i>	McArtor rushed for 280 yards with four touchdowns in Licking Valley's 58-7 win over Ready.
<i>Anthony Melchiori – Aurora</i>	Melchiori had 256 all-purpose yards in Aurora's 52-21 win over Revere. Melchiori returned two kick-offs for touchdowns (85, 87), had a 50-yard touchdown reception, kicked a 22-yard field-goal, and kicked seven extra-points.
<i>Dyonte Morgan – Briggs</i>	Morgan rushed for 328 yards with three scores in Briggs' 34-6 win over St. Paris Graham.
<i>Demarco Ruffin – Oak Hills</i>	Ruffin rushed for 221 yards with two touchdowns to lead Oak Hills to a 32-13 win over Loveland.
<i>Kyle Sess – Sycamore</i>	Sess rushed for 300 yards on 33 carries and scored three

	touchdowns to lead Sycamore to a 33-20 win over Springfield.
<i>Donyelle Simpson – Heath</i>	Simpson rushed for 241 yards with two touchdowns in Heath's 46-13 win over Utica.
<i>De'Veon Smith – Howland</i>	Smith rushed for 245 yards with a 78-yard touchdown run as Howland edged Warren Hardeing, 16-15.
<i>Jack Snowball – Wadsworth</i>	Snowball rushed for 176 yards while returning a kick-off for a 94-yard touchdown as Wadsworth knocked off Medina 23-6.
<i>Mitch Trubisky – Mentor</i>	Trubisky had 553 yards of total offense with five touchdowns as Mentor beat St. Ignatius, 38-24. Trubisky threw for 469 yards with three scores and rushed for 84 yards with two touchdowns.
<i>James Walsh – Dublin Coffman</i>	Walsh had 372 yards of total offense with three touchdowns in Coffman's 34-16 win over Massilon Perry. Walsh threw for 278 yards with three scores and rushed for a team-high 94 yards in the win.
