<i>Terrell Byrd – Brunswick</i>	Byrd had 10 receptions for 229 yards with three touchdowns in helping Brunswick edge Garfield Heights, 35-34.
<i>Corry Benson – Marion-Franklin</i>	Benson threw 329 yards with six touchdowns as Marion-Franklin knocked off Independence 54-30.
<i>Gary Brown – Westerville South</i>	Brown rushed for 152 yards with three touchdowns to lead Westerville South to a 45-42 win over Dublin Scioto.
<i>Tevin Brown – North College Hill</i>	Brown rushed for 172 yards with a touchdown while making a touchdown catch in North College Hill's 20-0 win over Summit.
<i>J.Q. Bowers – Sylvania Southview</i>	Bowers had 173 receiving yards with two scores (71, 82) in Southview's 45-27 win over Maumee.
<i>Kumar Collins – Reynoldsburg</i>	Collins had 200 rushing yards with two scores as Reynoldsburg beat Newark, 36-10.
<i>Kenneth Davis – Walnut Hills</i>	Davis has 260 yards of total offense with four touchdowns to lead Walnut Hills to a 31-29 win over Winton Woods. Davis rushed for 149 yards with two scores and had four receptions for 111 yards with two additional touchdowns.
<i>David Fraley – Granville</i>	Fraley threw for 341 yards with four scores to lead Granville to a 28-21 win over Licking Valley.
<i>Ben Gedeon – Hudson</i>	Gedeon rushed for 113 yards with three touchdowns to lead Hudson to a 26-7 win over Cuyahoga Falls.
<i>D.J. Jones - Ravenna</i>	Jones rushed for 205 yards with two scores to lead Ravenna to a 35-7 win over Coventry.
<i>Josh Makuch – Liberty Union</i>	Makuch rushed for 171 yards with one score to lead Liberty Union to a 24-21 win over Licking Heights.
<i>Alex Mickley – Hilliard Davidson</i>	Mickley rushed for 235 yards with three touchdowns to lead Hilliard Davidson to a 33-0 win over Thomas Worthington.
<i>Chet Saum – Amanda-Clearcreek</i>	Saum rushed for 182 yards with two scores to lead Amanda-Clearcreek to a 28-13 win over Canal Winchester.

<i>Jack Snowball – Wadsworth</i>	Snowball rushed for 138 yards with three touchdowns and threw for another touchdown as Wadsworth knocked off Revere, 42-0.
<i>Zach Thompson – Hamilton Township</i>	Thompson had five touchdown tosses as Hamilton Township knocked off Circleville, 49-6.
<i>Anthony Vagnier – Logan Elm</i>	Vagnier had five total touchdowns to lead Logan Elm to a 35-14 win over Teays Valley. Vagnier threw for 233 yards and had a 55-yard scoring run.
<i>Jody Webb – Whitmer</i>	Webb rushed for 209 yards with two touchdown runs (85, 59) while catching a nine-yard scoring pass in Whitmer's 35-7 win over St. John's Jesuit.
<i>Jamire Westbrook – Kings</i>	Westbrook rushed for 189 yards with two scores to lead Kings to a 30-0 win over Glen Este.
<i>Dorian Williams – Streetsboro</i>	Williams ran for 214 yards with five scores in Streetsboro's 42-27 win over Springfield.
<i>Jacob Wilson – Columbus Academy</i>	Wilson threw for 213 yards with three scores in Columbus Academy's 20-10 win over Newark Catholic.
