Ryley Claborn – Bethany	Claborn threw for 307 yards with four touchdowns in Bethany's 41-20 win over Blanchard.
Adam Dolan – Berryhill	Dolan rushed for 149 yards and scored two touchdowns in a 34-27 win over Glenpool.
Casey Curtis – Putnam City	Curtis rushed for 308-yards with six touchdowns to lead Putnam City to a 63-28 win over Putnam City North.
Hunter Eubank – Lindsay	Eubank threw for 574 yards with six touchdowns in a 48-46 shootout loss to Purcell.
Andrew Hearon – Metro Christian	Hearon threw for 421 yards with five touchdowns to lead Metro Christian to a 46-10 win over Oklahoma Christian.
Kendall Holmes – Union	Holmes rushed for 148 yards with two touchdown runs to lead Union to a 21-0 win over Evangel Christian (LA).
Corden Jones – Yukon	Jones went 18-for-23 passing with 285 yards and four touchdowns to lead Yukon to a 44-31 win over Mustang.
Wilson Klutts – Poteau	Klutts had 471 yards of total offense with five touchdowns in Poteau's 38-35 win over Checotah. Klutts threw for 380 yards with four scores while rushing for 91 yards with another touchdown.
Garrett Roach – Woodward	Roach rushed for 160 yards with a touchdown as Woodward knocked off El Reno, 12-7.
Mike Miller – Davenport	Miller scored four touchdowns (6, 59, 48, 10) as Davenport outscored Dewar, 49-36.
Jacob Smart – Minco	Smart rushed for 124 yards with five scores as Minco rolled over Dibble, 40-14.
Drake Stevens – Glenpool	Stevens had six receptions for 207 yards with two touchdowns in Glenpool's 34-27 loss to Berryhill.
Trevor Thompson – Westmoore	Thompson threw for 219 yards with four scores to lead Westmoore to a 34-11 win over Moore.
Sheldon Wilson – Anadarko	Wilson rushed for 200 yards with five touchdowns as Anadarko rolled over Chickasha, 55-14.
Cameron Wrenn – Broken Arrow	Wrenn rushed for 315 yards with five touchdowns in Broken Arrow's 48-29 win over Owasso.
