Marine Corps Elite Warrior of the Week - Nominees

<i>Michael Cantu – Carroll</i>	Cantu threw for 263 yards with four touchdowns to lead Carroll to a 52-7 win over Ray.
<i>Dawson Gamble – Regents</i>	Gamble scored three touchdowns to lead Regents to a 34-23 win over St. Stephen's, rushing for 135 yards with two scores while returning an interception for a 65-yard touchdown.
<i>Joseph Glenn – Giddings</i>	Glenn rushed for 244 yards with three touchdowns while returning the opening kick-off of the second-half for a 75-yard score as Giddings opened with a 35-19 win over Burnet.
<i>David Herrera – Southside</i>	Herrera rushed for 112 yards and scored four touchdowns in Southside's 37-6 win over Pearsall.
<i>Sterling Holmes – Antonian</i>	Holmes carried the ball 13 times for 163 yards with three touchdowns as Antonian knocked off Lanier, 34-27.
<i>Daje Johnson – Hendrickson</i>	Johnson had 432 yards of total offense with 377 rushing yards and two touchdowns in leading Hendrickson to a 28-26 win over Vista Ridge.
<i>Quaylon Jones – Judson</i>	Jones rushed for 190 yards with four touchdowns in Judson's 49-0 win over MacArthur.
<i>Lawrence Mattison – Smithson Valley</i>	Mattison ran for 171 yards on 25 carries with two touchdowns as Smithson Valley whipped Odessa Permian, 40-27.
<i>Levi Medley – Lehman</i>	Medley rushed for 200 yards and threw a touchdown pass to lead Lehman to a 20-9 win over St. Michael's.
<i>Parks McNeil – Kerrville Tivy</i>	McNeil threw for 370 yards with four touchdowns to lead Kerrville Tivy to a 46-0 win over Fredericksburg.
<i>Jared Owens – Warren</i>	Owens had 10 carries for 194 yards with three touchdowns in Warren's 63-13 win over Southwest.
<i>Greg Pitre – Hutto</i>	Pitre rushed for 184 yards with four touchdowns in Hutto's 43-28 win over LBJ.

<i>David Rogers – Boerne Champion</i>	Rogers rushed for 164 yards with two touchdowns as Boerne Champion's 51-28 win over East Central.
<i>Justin Stockton – Steele</i>	Stockton rushed for 143 yards with two scores and grabbed the game-winning 20-yard touchdown pass with less than six minutes to play as Steele rallied for a 35-28 win over Madison.
<i>Desmond Wyatt – Westwood</i>	Wyatt recorded 113 receiving yards and grabbed two touchdown passes in Westwood's 21-13 win over Cedar Park.
<i>Trinton Ynclan – Brandeis</i>	Ynclan rushed for 172 yards with four touchdowns, kicked a 21-yard field-goal, and booted three extra-points as Brandeis beat Johnson, 36-28.
