Marine Corps Elite Warrior of the Week - Nominees

<i>Elijah Ball – Reagan</i>	Ball rushed for 186 yards with three scores to lead Reagan to a 31-8 win over O'Connor.
<i>Darik Dillard – MacArthur</i>	Dillar had 26 carries for 181 yards with two scores in MacAruthr's 33-28 win over Stevens.
<i>Bryce Dunman – New Braunfels Canyon</i>	Dunman ran for a touchdown, caught a touchdown pass, recovered a fumble, and had a sack as New Braunfels Canyon beat East Central, 35-8.
<i>Dawson Gamble – Regents</i>	Gamble had five receptions for 151 yards with two touchdowns (43, 58), carried the ball once for 64 yards, and intercepted a pass on defense in Regents' 47-13 win over St. Andrew's.
<i>Bobby Garza – McCollum</i>	Garza ran for 183 yards on 16 carries with three touchdowns as McCollum whipped South San Antonio, 43-14.
<i>Quinta Goode – St. Michael's</i>	Goode scored four touchdowns to lead St. Michael's to a 70-7 win over Reagan. Good had a 98-yard touchdown run and returned a kick-off for a 90-yard score.
<i>Brandon Hamilton – Copperas Cove</i>	Hamilton rushed for 230 yards with two touchdowns in Copperas Cove's 41-31 win over Waco.
<i>Max Heintzelman – Antonian</i>	Heintzelman had seven receptions for 124 yards and scoring catches of 35 and 20 yards in Antonian's 33-0 win over Burbank.
<i>Secody Howard – Lampasas</i>	Howard rushed for 192 yards with two touchdowns as Lampasas blanked Travis, 28-0.
<i>Quaylon Jones – Judson</i>	Jones rushed for 194 yards and all three Judson touchdowns in a 21-14 win over Leander.
<i>Baker Mayfield – Lake Travis</i>	Mayfield scored six touchdowns to lead Lake Travis to a 43-15 win over Hendrickson, throwing for 256 yards and five scores while rushing for another touchdown.

<i>JeQuan McBride – Sam Houston</i>	McBride rushed for 204 yards with four touchdowns in Sam Houston's 58-7 romp over Southside.
<i>Levi Medley – Kyle Lehman</i>	Medley recorded 256 yards of total offense with three touchdowns in Kyle Lehman's 40-0 win over Edison. Medley rushed for 151 yards with two scores while making four catches for 102 yards and a touchdown.
<i>Xavier McElhannon – Johnson</i>	McElhanon rushed for 145 yards on 10 carries with two scores in Johnson's 49-14 win over Jay.
<i>Parks McNeil – Kerrville Tivy</i>	McNeil had 180 yards rushing on 18 carries with three touchdowns in Kerrville Tivy's 48-7 win over Madison.
<i>Cory Raley – Uvalde</i>	Raley rushed for 194 yards with three touchdowns as Uvalde outscored Eagles Pass, 39-32.
<i>Te'Rel Simmons – Elgin</i>	Simmons had 223 yards of total offense with five touchdowns in Elgin's 42-14 win over Lanier.
<i>Trinton Ynclan - Brandeis</i>	Ynclan rushed for 238 yards with three touchdowns as Brandeis outscored Boerne Champion, 47-30.
