The parties to this agreement enter into this partnership on the eighteenth (18th) day of May 2012. TSF Radio Network, LLC will host an event under the name of the ARMY STRONG KS-v-MO Border Challenge on the thirtieth (30th) day of June 2012 at SHAWNEE MISSION WEST.

The USPL agrees to the following:

- USPL accepts all financial responsibility for the hosting of the event;
- USPL agrees to provide a current certificate of liability insurance certificate of no less than \$1,000,000 of general liability coverage with \$5,000 medical payment endorsements;
- USPL agrees to donate \$500 to the SHAWNEE MISSION WEST Athletic Department, BOOSTER CLUB, or other school-designated organization. Payment will be made to organization, not any individual.
- USPL agrees to provide staffing for the game-management of the event;
- USPL agrees to compensate game officials;
- USPL agrees and strongly encourages that HOST engage in athletic department/booster club fundraising opportunities, including but not limited to

concession sales, admission to the venue, and other fundraising activities. USPL relinquishes any and all fiduciary claim to monies generated by these activities on behalf of HOST. As such, HOST absolves USPL from any and all liability from these fundraising activities.

USPL has contracted with the U.S. Army Kansas City Recruiting Battalion to host this event FREE of charge for the participating high schools, which may number 16-20 teams and agrees that USPL is the sole entity responsible for fulfilling the provisions of its contract with the U.S. Army and absolves HOST of any liability resulting from USPL's negligence in fulfilling the provisions of the contract.

USPL reserves the right to contract with additional local, regional, and national sponsors for the event, but agrees that all sponsors must meet the final approval of HOST.

- USPL agrees to abide by the West Shore School District's provisions for hosting event at HOST site.

HOST agrees to the following provisions of this agreement:

-HOST, partnership with USPL, agrees to host 16-20 team tournament, providing PPL with access to two fields, including the artificial turf field, bathroom facilities, concessions, locker rooms, press box, scoreboard, and any reasonable access to any other building on-site to ensure a safe event for the participating student-athletes;

-HOST agrees to provide USPL with limited game-day logistical support for the event.

-HOST agrees to allow the PPL to engage in reasonable marketing activities involving the U.S. Army, including: placing banners throughout the facility; positioning of tents at the facility; and distributing U.S. Army materials to the participating student-athletes and fans.

-HOST reserves the right of approval for any additional sponsors if they do not conform to the standards set forth by the HOST school.
